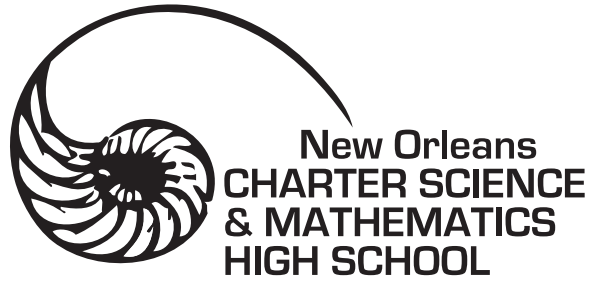

The original Science and Math High School

The Sci High mission is to provide a rigorous educational environment with an emphasis on science, technology, engineering and mathematics (STEM) fields, as well as to prepare students traditionally under-served by the public school system for college and career success.

The Advanced Placement (AP) Program:

Sci High offers all juniors and seniors the opportunity to test their skills in authentic college level courses known as AP or Advanced Placement classes. Students can elect to take AP calculus, chemistry, biology, physics, environmental science, statistics, English language/literature and composition, and US History. We have Pre-AP English II, Pre-AP Chemistry, and Algebra II Honors. These are college level courses that can earn students credit where they enroll. Sci High is one of four public high schools in New Orleans participating in the AdvanceNOLA AP Program.

Internships

Sci High places students in research and business environments where they can continue learning during the summer months. The program allows students to gain real-world experience and learn valuable life skills. Students are paid a modest stipend while they learn basic skills, such as coming to work on time, laboratory safety precautions, and teamwork that will help them to be successful in college and the workplace. Summer Science Internship partners have included Tulane Cancer Center, LSU Health Sciences Center and ABC/26 News.

Extracurricular Activities

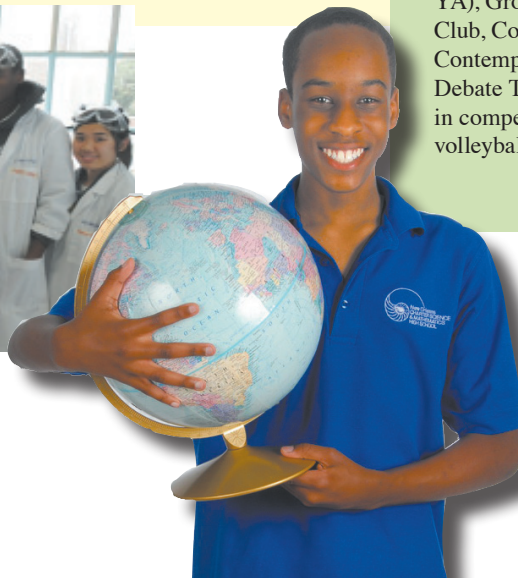
During the 2010/2011 school year at Sci High, New Orleans Outreach brought in an abundance of daytime and afterschool programming, including Young Artists/ Young Aspirations (YA/YA), Grow Dat!, Basketball, Spirit Team, Interact Club, Cooking, Robotics, Dance, NOLA Fund, Contemporary Band, tutoring, an award-winning Debate Team and more. Students also participate in competitive interscholastic sports including volleyball, basketball, football and track.

Located in a safe, small campus Uptown, Sci High is a public charter school that offers rigorous courses in all subjects including math, humanities, technology and much more. 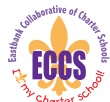
Sci High Success:

- In 2009, Sci High ranked 3rd in the district in math scores on the iLEAP test; only two selective admissions high schools scored higher.
- Sci High ranks 4th in the district on the Graduate Exit Exam in Science, behind only selective-admissions schools.
- Since 1996, Sci High has sent teams to the Bayou Regional Robotics Competition and come home with awards.
- Sci High students have gained 11 total percentage points in science and math from 2009 to 2010 (based on combined GEE results.)
- Over 90% of Sci High graduates attend colleges and universities all over the United States, including Harvard, Georgia Tech, Loyola-New Orleans, Xavier, Stanford, Dillard, LSU, Maryland Institute College of Art, Middlebury and Northwestern University in Illinois.
- Sci High's advanced curriculum includes classes in Astronomy, Geology, Environmental Science and computer certification, as well as extensive AP classes.
- Sci High welcomes New Orleans Center for Creative Arts (NOCCA) students.
- Every student gets the opportunity to go on at least two college trips to places like Boston, Chicago, Washington DC, New York, and throughout the Mississippi Delta to look at prospective schools.
