- Teaching ELA and Reading intervention classes as assigned

- Actively engage in weekly professional development and professional meetings.
- Design, turn in and revise lesson and unit plans.
- Invite observations and feedback and strive to continually improve their teaching

- Maintain a rigorous and engaging classroom and implement school-wide student management system everywhere on campus.
- Build positive rapport with students. Establish and maintain strong communication with all parents.
